SANDY HOLLOW RECREATION AREA

Sandy Hollow is located 2 miles east of the Sioux Center Hospital on county road B30. Park is open daily from 7:00 am to 10:30 pm. Administration Office, located at Oak Grove, is open Monday–Friday 8:00 am to 4:30 pm.

This 120 acre area offers many outdoor activities and 2 ponds consisting of 4 acres of water. The area includes a campground, hiking trails, swimming beach, fishing, and much more.

VEHICLE PASSES

Annual or daily vehicle passes are required for this area. These passes are available for purchase upon entering this park or can be purchased at the Administration Office at Oak Grove. Passes are also good at the Big Sioux Recreation Area near Hawarden. Passes are good January – December of calendar year they are purchased.

RECREATION

This area is open to the public for outdoor recreation activities including: fishing, playground equipment, basketball, volleyball, horseshoe pit, geocaching, na-



ture studies, hiking, cross country skiing, and much more.

CAMPING

There are 37 campsites at this location. Three types of sites provide electric; electric and water; and electric, water & sewer hook-ups.



Electrical is 50, 30, & 20 amp services. Sites are gravel pads varying in length. Dump station and water refill available for campers, along with a modern restroom. Firewood is available for purchase. All campsites are available on a first-come, first-served basis. Firewood is available for purchase.

RENTALS

There are two open shelters available to the public on a first-come, first-served basis. These shelters have picnic tables for seating.



The clubhouse is available by reservation only. This building has a capacity for 150 people. Included in rental are: banquet tables, chairs, small dance floor, kitchen-

ette, modern restroom, and access to the swimming beach (not exclusive access). Vehicle passes must also be obtained for these reservations.

ARCHERY RANGE

Indoor and outdoor archery ranges are available for use



daily from sunrise to sunset or park hours. The outdoor range is open to the general public. The indoor range is open to members only. Fees pertain to both ranges. Please see sign or park staff for more information.

FISHING

The ponds found at Sandy Hollow have been stocked with catfish, largemouth bass, bluegill, and crappies. County fishing regulations are posted. Other regulations in accordance with State of Iowa Regulations.

BIKE TRAIL

This paved bike trail spans 3 miles and goes from Sandy Hollow to the city of Sioux Center.

PROGRAMS

Programs are offered year round by Sioux County Naturalists. Annual programs brought to you by the Sioux County Conservation Board and additional groups include: Ringneck Rendezvous, Trick or Treat Hike, Hunter Education Course, Family Fishing Clinics, Owl Prowl, Outdoor Skills Day, Women in the Outdoors, Women in the Outdoors, and Summer Camps. Many programs are family orientated.
